To the students taking the Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam on November 5-7, 2025: Please take note of the following:

- ➤ The Erasmus first stage examination will be held in Classroom F on the 6th floor of Block C, on November 5th at 2:00 PM.
- > The examination duration is 90 minutes.
- ➤ The examination consists of two stages. The first stage includes Reading, Use of English, and Lexis sections.
- > Students who score 55 points or above in the first stage will qualify to proceed to the second stage, which is the Speaking Section.
- ➤ The second stage of the examination will take place on November 7th at 1:30 PM in Classroom E, on the 6th floor of Block C.
- The first stage carries a total of 75 points, while the second stage is worth 25 points.
- > Students who arrive after the examination has started will only be admitted between 02:00 PM and 2:15 PM. Latecomers arriving after this time will not be permitted to enter.
- During the examination, students are not allowed to leave the examination room within the first 15 minutes of the start time and within the last 15 minutes before the conclusion of the examination.
- Please ensure that your mobile phones are turned off during the examination.
- ➤ Entry to and exit from the examination rooms will be supervised and controlled by examination proctors.
- Lists of students assigned to each examination room will be provided to the students by the examination proctor both before and after the examination. Students will be required to sign this list after undergoing a photo ID verification.
- > Students found attempting to cheat in any way during the examination will have their papers confiscated by the examination proctor, and their examination will be invalidated.
- ➤ Once the examination papers are distributed, each student must write their name, surname, and Turkish ID number in the upper left corner of the first page and sign beneath it. Additionally, students must verify that the page numbers correspond correctly and report any discrepancies to the examination proctor.
- Please note that there will be no rescheduling of the examination or re-examination for students who are unable to attend for any reason or have their examination invalidated.

We urge all students to take these guidelines seriously and wish you the best of luck in your Erasmus+ examination.
